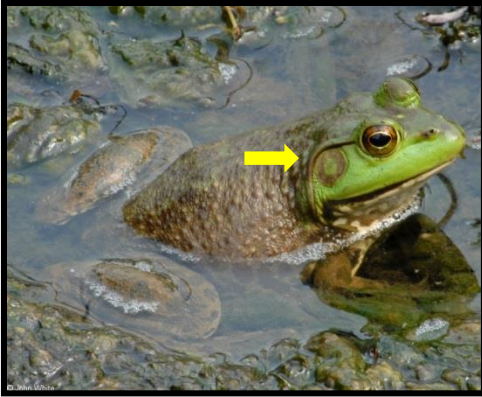


# Common Backyard Herps

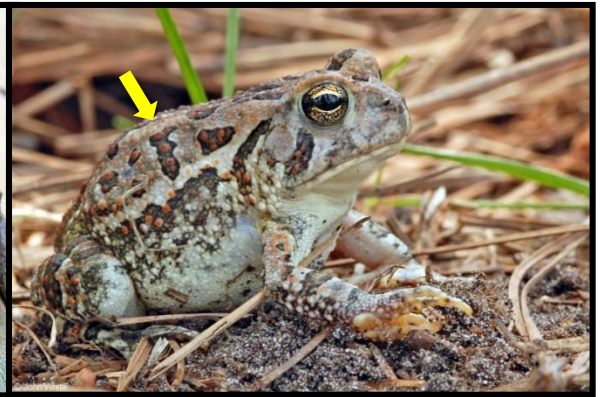

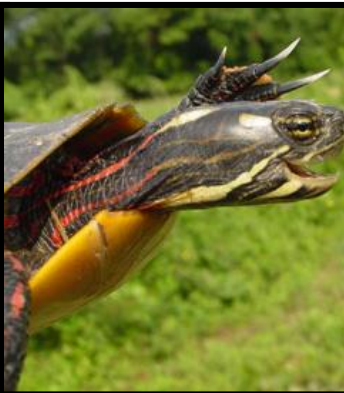
