MANDATORY HUNTER SAFETY TRAINING

No person may obtain a hunting license or hunt in Maryland unless (s)he has complied with Maryland's hunter safety education requirements found at Annotated Code of Maryland, Natural Resources Article, Section 10-301.1.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER REQUIREMENT

The Annotated Code of Maryland requires the collection of Social Security numbers (last 4 digits only) from all hunting license applicants (Natural Resources Article, Section 10-301). The Department's Privacy Policy prohibits the display of your Social Security number on any documents accessible to the general public. It can only be used by the Department in carrying out its governmental functions and cannot be released to anyone else without your express permission.
